The Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida is accepting applications for the position of Investigator for the Tallahassee Office.

Job Description and Qualifications:

To qualify, the applicant must be a high school graduate or equivalent and have at least three years of investigative experience and a valid driver's license. A four-year college degree is highly desirable. Criminal defense experience is preferred. Applicants must have strong organizational skills and broad familiarity with computer programs.

Additional preferred experience or skills:

- Experience conducting interviews, locating records and people, and writing comprehensive descriptive reports
- Experience investigating mitigating circumstances, including mental health history and personal and family history
- Ability to establish a rapport with many different kinds of people

Salary and Benefits:

The starting salary will be commensurate with experience. The position is full-time with federal benefits, including health and life insurance, retirement, and the Thrift Savings Plan. Applicant must be a US citizen. Salary is payable only by direct deposit. A final offer of employment is subject to funding and a background check.
