The Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida is seeking a trial attorney for the branch office in Pensacola. **This is an approved backfill that is excepted from the nationwide Defender Services' hiring freeze.**

Applicants must have at least three years of criminal trial experience. Trial skills, the ability to work with all kinds of people, research and writing skills, the maturity to interact collegially with court personnel and prosecutors, a willingness to work as hard and as long as it takes to get the job done, and a demonstrated commitment to clients are essential. Federal court experience and membership in The Florida Bar

are advantages, but not prerequisites. Membership in, or immediate eligibility for membership to, the Bar for the Northern District of Florida is a prerequisite.

The area has a rich sports history, and has its own minor league baseball team, the Pensacola Blue Wahoos, its own professional ice hockey team, the Pensacola Ice Flyers, and enjoys collegiate sporting action from the University of West Florida and Pensacola State College. Aside from all its amenities, Pensacola is truly "the Upside of Florida" and offers a quality of life that is not available in larger cities - the cost of living is 85% lower than San Francisco, 17% lower than New Orleans, and 59% lower than Washington, D.C., per the Forbes.com Cost of Living Calculator.

Employment is conditioned upon a favorable background check. Salary will be based on experience, consistent with federal rules and regulations. Salary includes federal benefits, with health and life insurance, retirement, and the Thrift Savings Plan. Position is subject to approval of funding.
