## Law Student Intern/Extern

The Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida seeks unpaid part-time interns in our Tallahassee office for the fall and spring semesters and full-time interns for the summer. We can supervise externships, for which students receive course credit from their law schools. Interns and externs will have the opportunity to work one-on-one with trial attorneys and our on-staff investigator. Interns primarily research legal issues and write memoranda for trial attorneys. Interns also may be asked to draft pleadings to be filed in the U.S. District Court, visit detention centers to meet with clients, and assist with field investigations. Interns are strongly encouraged to accompany lawyers to court proceedings. Our goal is to expose interns to all facets of the federal criminal legal system and indigent criminal defense work while helping students improve their research and writing skills.

## **Qualifications**

Applicants must have completed a law school course in evidence. Applicants should have an interest in indigent defense and direct client representation. Applicants need strong research and writing skills and the ability to adhere to deadlines.
